The Cabinet makes the following Regulations under Section 130 of the *Public Service Act 2016*:

**1 Citation**

These Regulations may be cited as the *Public Service (Government Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 2025*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on the date they are notified in the Gazette.

**3 Amendment of the Public Service (Government Vehicles) Regulations 2017**

The *Public Service (Government Vehicles) Regulations 2017* is amended by these Regulations.

**4 Amendment of Regulation 5**

Regulation 5 is amended by:

(a) deleting paragraph (c) and substituting with:

‘(c) Red – for official purposes, and shall be parked at such car park and during such times and days, as designated by the Head of Department;’ ;

(b) deleting subregulation (2) and substituting with:

‘(2) A designated driver of a vehicle, may seek approval of exemption from subregulation (1) and such exemption may only be granted by the Chief Secretary by notice in writing, submitted to the designated driver through the relevant Head of Department.’.

**5 Amendment of Regulation 8**

Regulation 8 is deleted and substituted as follows:

**‘8 Rental vehicles**

- (1) A Head of Department shall not hire a rental vehicle for public service use, unless it is approved by the Chief Secretary.
- (2) A rental vehicle shall be parked at such car park and during such times and days, as designated by the relevant Head of Department.
- (3) A designated driver of a vehicle, may seek approval of exemption from subregulation (2) and such exemption may only be granted by the Chief Secretary by notice in writing, submitted to the designated driver through the relevant Head of Department.’.
