Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Regulations 2024

DESIGNATION OF A SPECIAL PROJECT

[Section 9(7), Regulation 34]

SL No. 4 of 2026

PURSUANT to the powers vested in Cabinet under *Section 9(7)* of the *Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Act 2024* ('Act') and as per Cabinet Resolution dated 29 January 2026, Cabinet designates the 'The Iruwa Initiative' as the Special Project for the purposes of *Section 9(7)* of the Act. The details of The Iruwa Initiative are as follows:

Name of the Special Project:

The Special Project shall be named the 'The Iruwa Initiative'.

Purpose:

The Iruwa Initiative is initiated to celebrate the first anniversary of the Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Program and to raise awareness of the recent pricing and policy changes.

Contribution Discount:

- (a) The contribution value for the special project is reduced from \$115,000 USD to \$90,000 USD for the main applicant for the duration of The Iruwa Initiative.
- (b) All other associated fees will remain as prescribed by the *Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Regulations 2024*.

Duration:

The Special Project will commence from 29 January 2026 to 30 June 2026.

Transitional arrangements:

- (a) All applications that have been accepted prior to the commencement date of the special project but have not yet paid their contribution amount will be eligible for the special project contribution discount.
- (b) All applications that have been accepted prior to the closing date of the special project will be eligible for the special project contribution discount.
